From I-5, take Highway 518 westbound (*Exit 154, near South Center Mall, where I-5 meets I-405*). When you get into Burien, Highway 518 turns into S. W. 148th Street. As you get into town, look for and turn right onto **Ambaum Blvd. S.W.** Proceed to S. W. 144th Street (the 2nd light) and turn left. Proceed 3 short blocks to **13th Avenue S.W.** and turn right. This will take you right into the park. We will be in the **south** picnic shelter!
